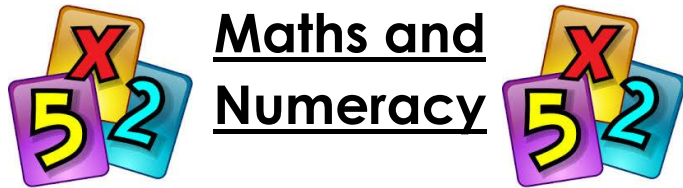

Maths and Numeracy

This block, our main focus will be on place value and multiplication. Mental Maths will be an integral part of each lesson and pupils would benefit from practising number bonds at home.

In class we will cover:

- Place value
- Revision of 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9x tables
- 2D and 3D shape
- Data handling
- Problem solving strategies

Language



- **Reading** - In addition to teacher-led reading sessions, children will take part in a range of reading activities in class to develop reading skills, comprehension and vocabulary. Children will visit the school library fortnightly. Children should bring their reading and library book daily.
- **Writing** – Our focus this term will be on writing recounts and procedural writing. It would be helpful if children could look at instructions and recipes at home.
- **Talking and Listening Skills** – Listening and talking skills will be developed through structured activities including recounting information from Newsround. Children will be developing presentation skills culminating in sharing their Oceans' research with the class.

Other Curricular Areas

Social Studies– Our class topic this term is Oceans Alive. We will be learning about the oceans, marine creatures and environmental issues relating to the oceans.



Art – We will be developing our drawing skills using a variety of media and our understanding of contrast.

RME – We will be learning about the Creation Stories of different world religions and cultures.

P.E – This term we will focus on ball skills & team games.

Drama – Our drama programme will have an Ocean theme this block.

I.C.T. – We will be using the internet to research the Oceans. We will continue to develop our coding skills.

Health – This term we are looking at values and what makes a good friend.
