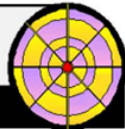
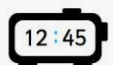

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Numbers up to 100,000 / 1,000,000</u></p> <p>Choose 5 numbers up to 1,000, 000</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Order the numbers forwards and backwards - Find the number halfway between the largest and smallest number - Write the numbers in words <p>Roll a dice up to six times to give you a number up to 1, 000 000.</p> <p>Write down the number 1 less/more than this? The number 3 tens less/more? The number 300 less/more? And so on.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Count Down</u></p> <p>Play this game with another person. One person writes down a 3-digit 'total' number. The other person writes down four numbers between 1 and 10 as well as three numbers which are multiples of 10, up to 100.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">e.g. Total: 437 Numbers: 4, 7, 9, 3, 20, 70, 50</p> <p>Set a two-minute timer and work out the total number by using the other numbers and any operations, e.g. +, -, ÷ and ×.
